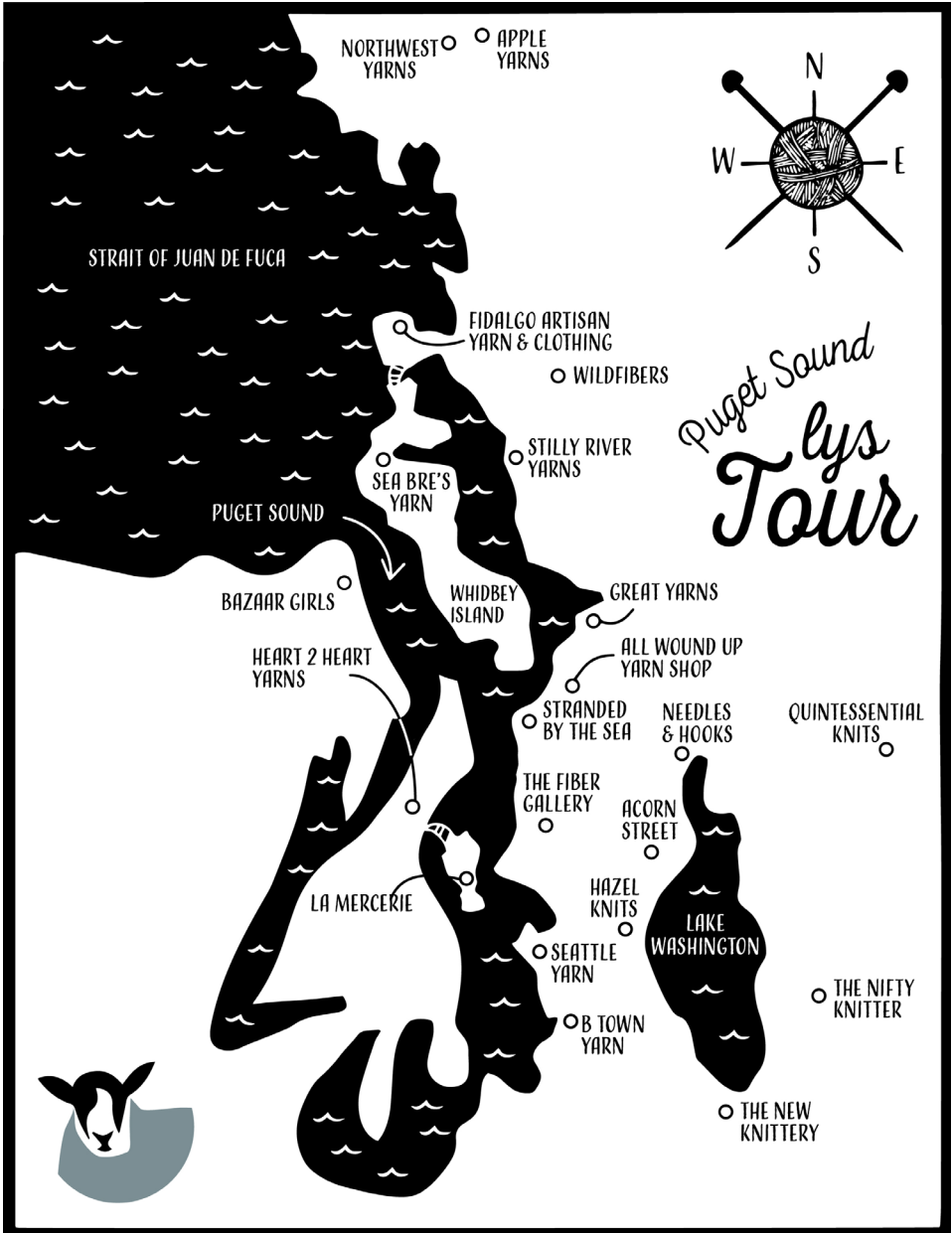
plan your route, and hit the road to see why a community of thriving local yarn shops (LYS) is a wonderful thing. Visit our website to find information about all participating shops.

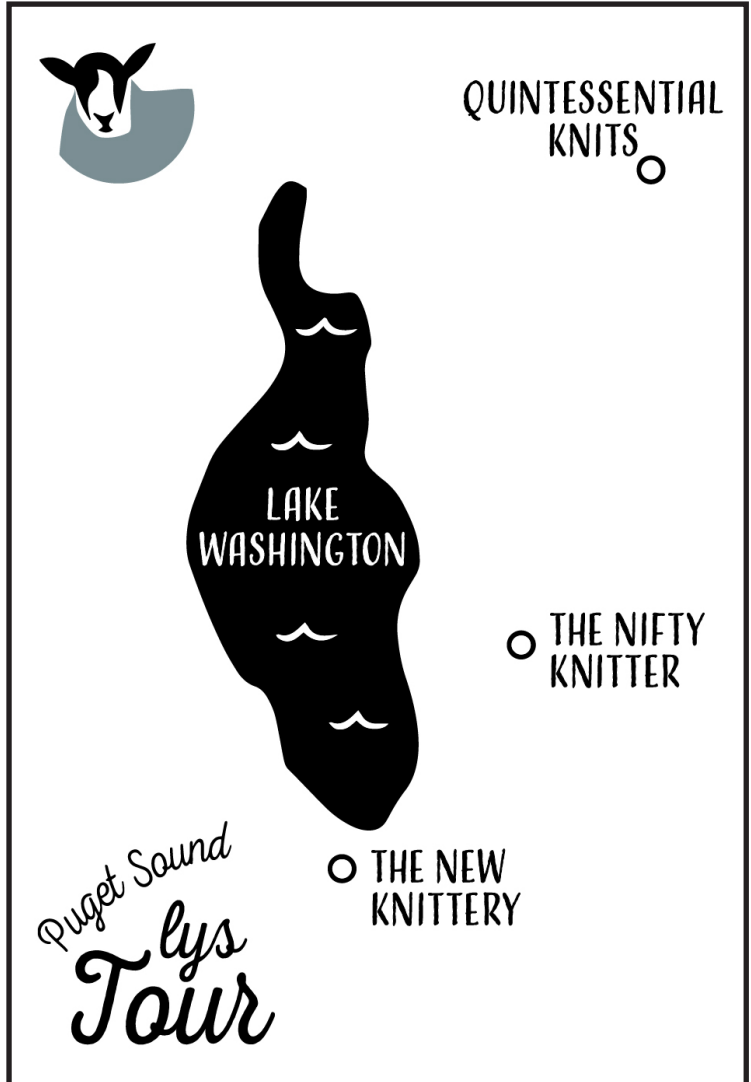
I-5 South take exit 164.

We are located on the left directly across the street from Honda/Toyota of Seattle. Our building is black with white trim and has large front windows - we are the front door.

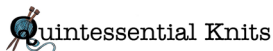

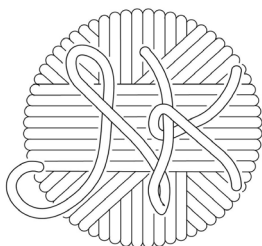
